from the myriad of cocktails available, a select few have stood the test of time and can rightfully be described classics - the following is a diverse list of such 'classics', done our way and we hope you enjoy them - of course if you have a better idea, we're happy to accommodate you.

mojito - an unbeatable thirst quencher from cuba, combining fragrant mint, lime, sugar, soda and latin rum

caipiroska - chilled like a moscow winter: this zingy vodka lime has russian strength

caipirinha - a zesty brazilian treasure, as famous as their football team: cachaca, muddled lime and raw sugar

cosmopolitan - a multi-culture of flavours: orange rind and citrus, cranberry and vodka; shaken and strained light pink

margarita - characteristically tart, this sharp mexican beauty showcases tequila as it should be, with cointreau and freshly squeezed lime juice to complete the balance; salted rim

long island iced tea - an intense combination of spirits and lemon, disguised by colour as an innocent iced tea: not a cuppa to be underestimated

japanese slipper - an iridescent, tree frog green drink, tasting of sweet melon and orange, cut with samurai sharp lemon. one too many and it's sayonara

pina colada -a puerto rican speciality with creamy coconut, rum and tropical pineapple, blended with ice

espresso martini - a silky smooth mix of strong black coffee and alcohol

french martini -fruity and sweet, with black raspberry and pineapple flavour profiles, it'll seduce the most timid drinker to the world of martinis. have merci

pitchers one litre: \$35.0

sangria - a traditional spanish punch made from red wine, orange juice, soda, brandy, cointreau, and fresh orange pieces: flavours come together seamlessly like salsa dancers

moscow mule - simple but effective: muddled lime, vodka and ginger beer, kicks like a mule pimm's - in wimbledon they say the only thing better than a pimm's cup, is a pimm's

traditional lemonade - made fresh from juicy lemons, balanced with sugar nectar, spiked with vodka and topped with fizzy soda, one glass is never enough, so take a pitcher
