Either way we have developed this epic drink into a new age masterpiece. Stirring together High West Double Rye, Maraschino liqueur, Sweet Vermouth and Burlesque bitters. All being slightly smoked by burning Cherry Wood chips. You be the Boss!

JAKE

When prohibition set in the population of the U.S. went to extreme lengths to smuggle alcohol into the country. 'Jake' was the slang term given to Jamaican Ginger, which contained between 70—80% ethanol. Well seeing as we don't want to send you blind by giving you that, we decided to use apples instead, throw in a bit of cinnamon and of course RUM!!

KAMEHAMEHA

King Kamehameha established the first Hawaiian language constitution in 1839. It signified Hawaii as the largest island in the archipelago. Over time English became the official language. In honour of the Kings efforts we have created a tropical punch served in a large Tiki Mug. We then finish it off with fruit and make it bubble like a volcano. It really makes you feel like putting on a grass skirt and dance the Hula.

VOIDED SUSPICION

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In the 16th Century, a banquet was done terribly different to the ones of today. The term banquet stemmed from the medieval term for '*ceremony of the void*'. It would be the time of an evening where the all guests would adjourn to a parlour as the table was cleared, or '*voided*' as the year indicates. We present you with a drink befitting a banquet itself, Applejack Brandy, Rosemary and Apple, all sweetened with a Strawberry Balsamic Reduction.

FLAPJACK

The pancake has been around since 5th century BC. It was a staple for many cultures all over the globe. The pancake has developed substantially over time, and it was the English in the late 15th century that made it the closest to what we do today. A traditionally pancake topping was always honey and lemon. We have taken these base ingredients and made them into a tantalizing drink. Cognac, Lemon, Maple Syrup and Vermouth

BROKEN ICE

Between 1942—1967 there were only 6 Professional Ice Hockey teams. In this 6 were the Detroit Red Wings and the New York Rangers. All 6 of these teams had a fierce rivalry, but none more so than the Red Wings and Rangers. Games were frequently underscored due to these inter-club player rivalries. So we have taken the Aviation, with a New York origin, and the Last Word, with a Detroit origin, and combined them together with the addition of Cachaça, to try and mend the broken Ice!

THE FRENCH CON!

DOM Benedictine was invented by *Alexandre Le Grand* in the 19th Century. He was aided by a local chemist, and use to use a story about the *Benedictine Abbey of Fécamp in Normandy's* devastation as a rouse to increase sales. He must have been the best turn of the century salesman. Lillet Rouge, DOM Benedictine, Absinthe and Peychauds, all French ingredients, stirred down and served neat. Will have you talking like a salesman in no time.

THE SKY WAS PINK

E.E. Cummings, one of the most brilliant poets of the early 1900's. His work was profound and inspiring. Having grown up in a Unitarian family, he learnt to appreciate all those around him. He exhibited transcendental learning his entire life. We have hand crafted a drink that will make you feel the way we do when we read his words. Uplifted, cared for and loved. There is a whole lot of love in this drink. Citron Vodka, Chambord, Apple, Raspberry and Rose Water.

CUBAN REDEMPTION

We all know that Cuba is the home of good cigars, sugar and of course RUM! It was the home of the Mojito, we won't hold that against them. But for Cuba to get where it is today, they had to go through a hectic journey involving the Spanish and Americans. Cuba was granted independence via the *Cuban—American Treaty* in 1903. And today we take their rum, mix it with a bit of home-made hazelnut syrup and a touch of Europe to give you a drink that would of ended the War years before it started.

THE LEBLON LYCAN

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Lycium Barbarum, also known as a wolfberry or Goji. Closely related to Deadly Nightshade. This berry is a commonly used ingredient in China. Used for centuries to aid in remedies. It has been well known for its pharmacological uses. Some folklore even lend its purposes to Lycanism. So we thought we would make our own remedy, a remedy of the night. Caçhaca, Goji, Passionfruit and Lime. Be warned, not wise to be consumed under the light of a full moon.

THE CLAIRVOYANT

Classic Cocktails & A Flair of Grace

FIZZ

A Fizz is a style of cocktail that derived from the sour. It essentially makes a sour into a long style drink through the addition of carbonated water. Flavour combinations are endless. Some classic versions are; Gin Fizz, Kings Fizz, Chicago Fizz, Diamond Fizz and the Morning Glory Fizz.

SOUR

Sours belong to one of the old families of original cocktails. Jerry Thomas describes a sour as a drink containing a *BASE, SOUR & SWEETENER*, more often then not egg white as well. To attain this formula, a large variety of flavours can be used. Most common sours are; Margarita, Sidecar, Amaretto Sour, Aviation, Bramble, Daiquiri, Last Word & a Penicillin.

COBBLER

The Cobbler, unlike most classic styles, primarily consist of one form of base, wine, with the addition of fresh fruit and sugar. The original Cobbler was the *Sherry Cobbler*, becoming one of the most popular libations during the last half of the 19th century. It also brought into practice the use of ice and straws. 2 very curious new oddities, that were very new at the time. Give us a flavour and we will make your world crumble.

MARTINI

The Martini has many forms. There is no limit to what the use of 'TINI' can be added to at the end of a drink name. Breakfast Martini, French Martini, Espresso Martini, Apple Martini or Lychee Martini. Also going even more classic and rustic like a Vesper or Martinez. Possibilities are endless.

OLD FASHIONED

The Old Fashioned is an IBA Official Cocktail, and one of only six mentioned by David A. Embury in the book 'The Fine Art of Mixing Drinks'. It takes 3 simple ingredients, sugar, bitters and a base. It is then stirred down to reveal the base flavours of the alcohol. Clean and delicious. It can have unlimited interpretations and flavour combinations. Ask a bartender his favourite, we all have one.
